During the War, Marshal oversaw operations in both Europe and the Pacific, reorganized the Army Air Corp, designed the plan that would become the Normandy invasion and hand-selected General Eisenhower to lead it. General Bradley - Quiet and thoughtful, General Omar Bradley earned a reputation for being a "Soldier's soldier". While never on the same level of tactical genius as General Patton, Bradley's demeanor and ability to work within the fragile framework of the Allied coalition made him indispensable to General Eisenhower. General Arnold - Taught to fly by the Wright Brothers, General Henry "Hap" Arnold became one of the most important figures in American aviation history. Always a forward thinker, Arnold fought and won the battle against the hierarchies of the army and navy to create an independent Air Force. His foresight and strategic vision were instrumental in creating the most powerful air force the world has ever known.
