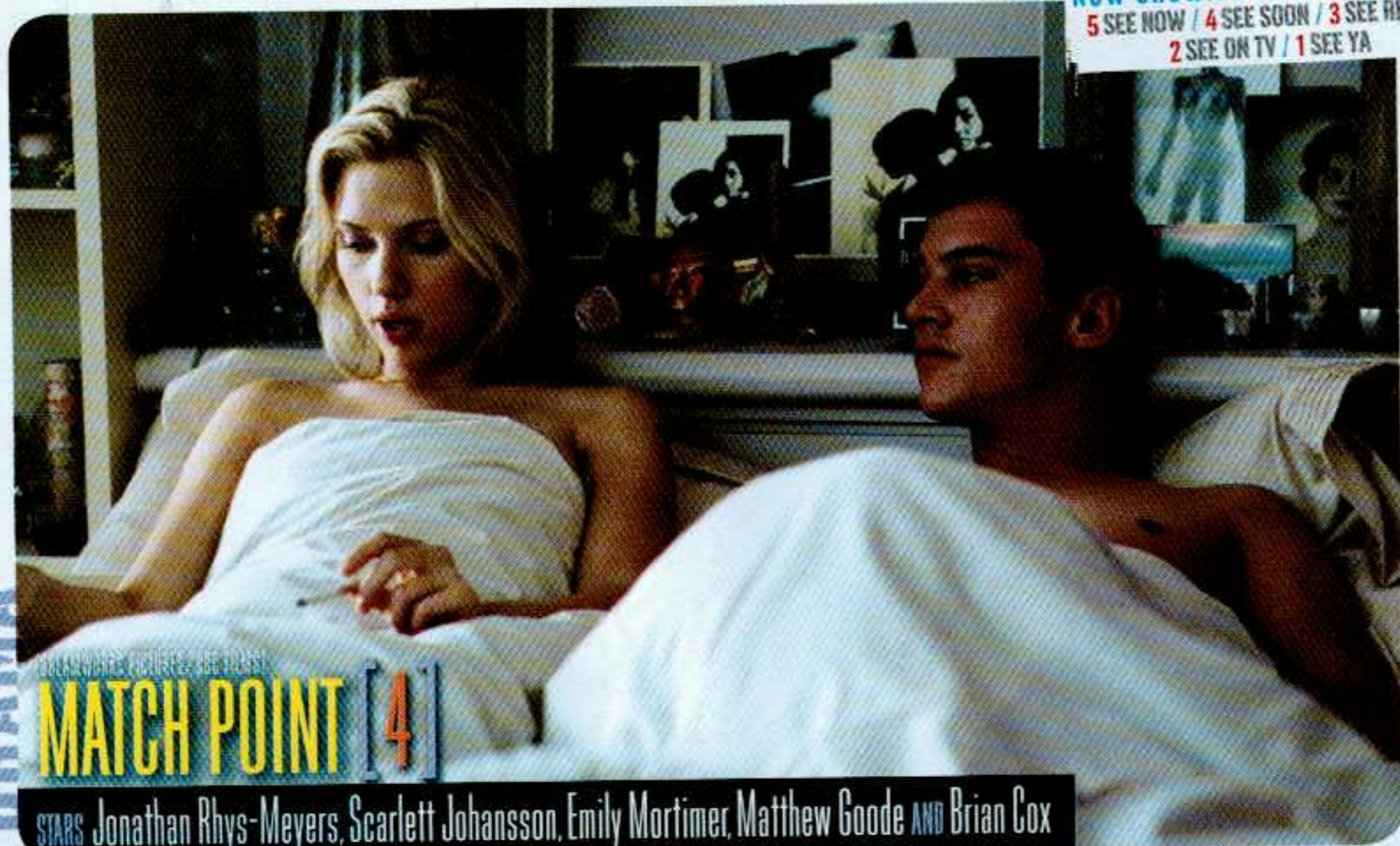

Audiences familiar with Woody Allen's recent spate of insular, near-pointless New York "comedies" may not even recognize *Match Point*—a sharp, meaty London thriller—as a Woody Allen film, when, really, it couldn't have been made by anyone else. Chris (Rhys-Meyers), an erudite tennis pro from a poor Irish upbringing, befriends Tom (Goode), an insanely rich British chap. Tom's sister Chloe (Mortimer) takes an instant liking

to Chris. Soon enough, Chris is married to Chloe, living in an insanely posh flat, working for the family firm—and sleeping with Tom's beguiling American fiancée, Nola (Johansson, in top form). The adulterous romantic entanglements are pure Woody, but so is his fixation on the luck that drives Chris's life. What's less familiar is how much dark bite Allen brings to his story; maybe he just had to get out of New York.
