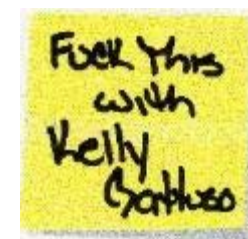

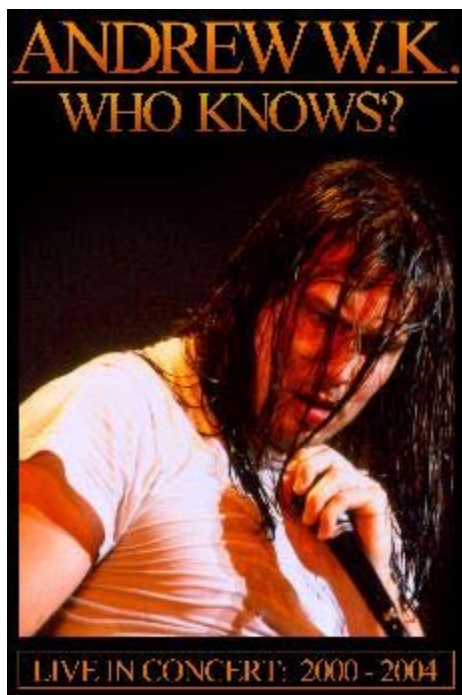

The feature length documentary, "All Dolled Up", follows the band from their early performances in New York at such clubs as Kenny's Castaways, and Max's Kansas City. It also documents their West Coast tour and includes footage from the Whisky-A-Go-Go, the Real Don Steele Show, Rodney Bingenheimer's E Club and more. Inter cut with revealing interviews, backstage banter, and late night debauchery, "All Dolled Up" is THE definitive document of the New York Dolls.

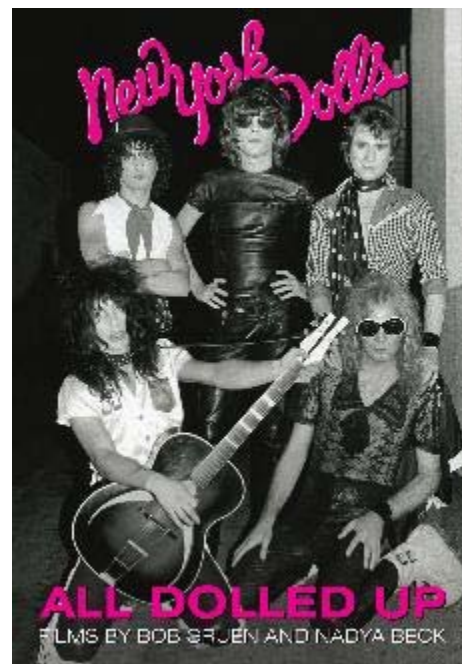

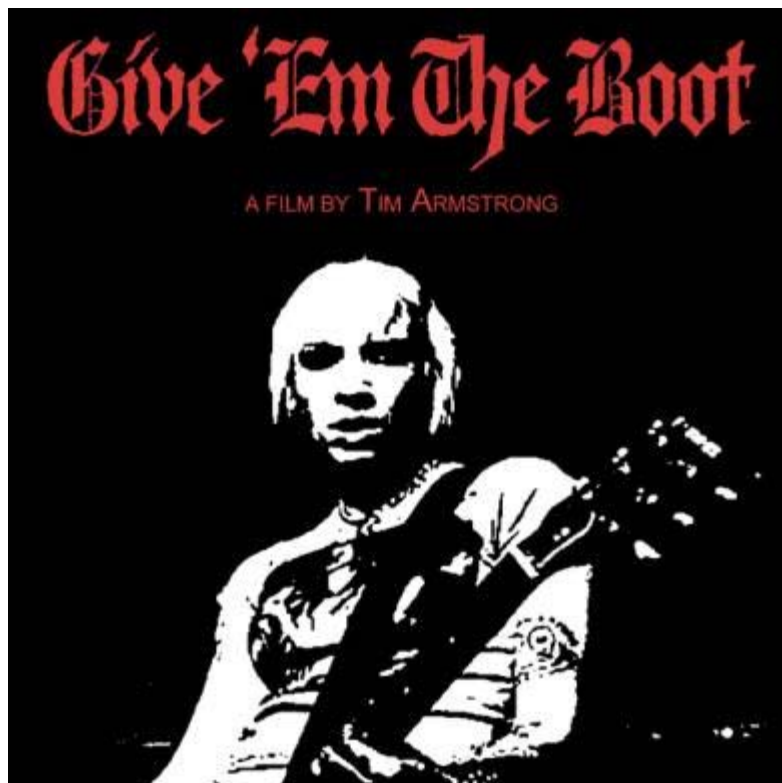

Artistically rendered in the "classic" Hellcat style, the GIVE 'EM THE BOOT DVD visuals are grainy, high-contrast and street-influenced. The visual style, however, does not reflect the audio portion of the DVD! The soundtrack is crisp, clear and extracted from media of the highest quality!

The GIVE 'EM THE BOOT DVD features an outstanding performance by Joe Strummer And The Mescaleros at The Brixton Academy, during the Global A Go-Go Tour shot with the help of Clash DJ, Clash Video and Filmmaker, B.A. D. member Don Letts and his crew, "b-roll" footage of Tim Armstrong performing Rancid's "Rats In The Hallway" acoustically over a montage of Rancid footage. You'll also find a terrific energetic backstage performance with Iggy Pop singing his classic "No Fun" with Rancid as his backing band. There are some extra added video perks featuring surprise cameos and duets from the likes of AFI's Davey Havok and a stellar piece about the making of the Joe Strummer And The Mescaleros tribute video for "Redemption Song".

Southern California punk rock legends BAD RELIGION plan to release Live At The Palladium DVD on February 21, 2006.

This DVD features extensive live footage that was shot over two nights at the famous Hollywood Palladium; this footage was condensed down to one spitfire performance containing extremely rare content such as an acoustic piano version of "Cease," in-depth interviews with all current band members discussing the band's formation, the evolution of the band's music and career as a whole.

Also included on the DVD is a mass of never-before-seen live footage from The New Wave Theatre (circa 1981-1983), a band photo gallery featuring new and vintage images of the band, as well as a myriad of BAD RELIGION production music videos.

Although filmed in 2005, this DVD serves as a career retrospective on one of the most beloved and respected punk

rock bands in the history of the genre with a career spanning more than twenty years total.
