

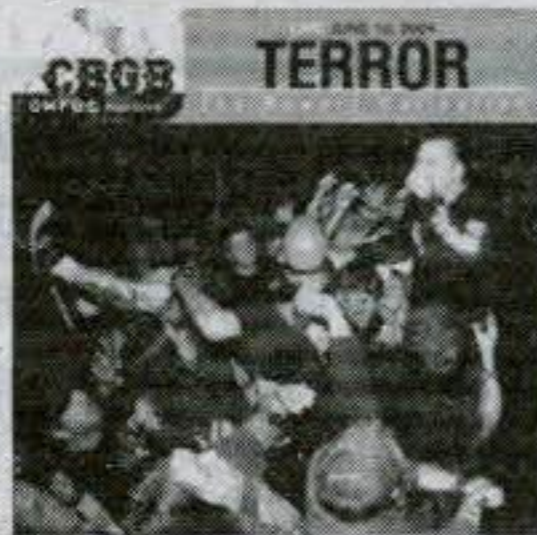

80's that brought this legendary club to my attention. Terror aren't from the 80's or even the 90's, but because of bands that play at CBGB like Cro-Mags, Agnostic Front, and Youth of Today we have this new breed of bands like Terror, Trash Talk, and Bane.

The recording on this CD is really good with most of the in between song talking cut out, leaving just the song introductions and the music. Every once in a while you can hear some crowd noise, especially during the sing a longs. The guitars are especially crisp and heavy sounding.
