Also on June 5, **iTunes** will exclusively release two dialogue tracks that were previously unreleased and will not be on the new album, as well as exclusive video footage of Bernhard performing live, also not on the album. ➤ Heading to Stores May 15 on **Legacy Recordings** is the soundtrack CD, *Joe Strummer: The Future is Unwritten*. The release predates the opening of the biopic, which heads to theaters this summer. Both releases commemorate

the 30th anniversary of the 1977 UK release of "White Riot," the debut single by **the Clash**, as well as the release of their self-titled debut album and the May Day opening of the historic **White Riot UK Tour**.

The film, by rock video pioneer and movie director **Julien Temple**, celebrates the influential punker by including not only Strummer's work with the Clash with rare recordings, but also representations of Strummer's other bands, **the 101ers** and **the Mescaleros**. 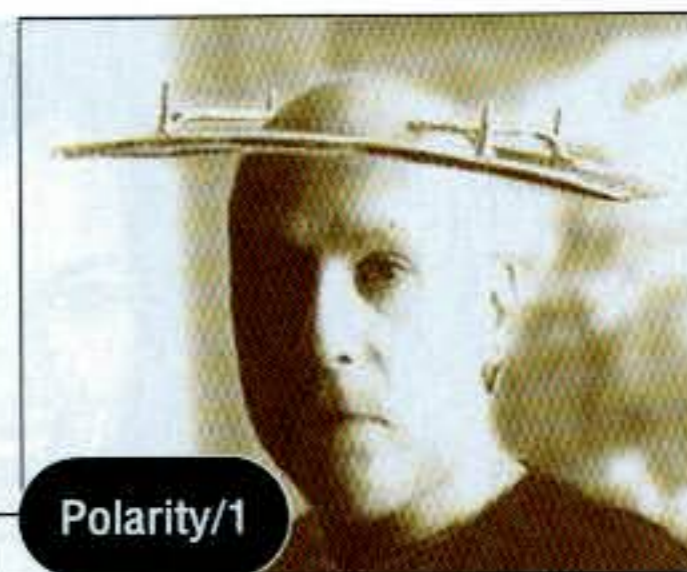
➤ *In Debt We Trust*, a feature-length documentary directed by Emmy winner **Danny Schechter**, will bring music by N.Y.-based composer and recording artist **Polarity/1** to theaters. The film features instrumental music by **Polarity/1** and **Audioplasm** (**Polarity/1** and **Rubio**) as well as two songs written for the film — "Free Money" (included on **Polarity/1's Prettier Than You** CD) and "I'm So Broke" by **Audioplasm**.

The film shows how debt is strangling the lives of tens of millions of Americans, and consolidating power into fewer and fewer hands by a credit and loan complex, producing a kind of "modern serfdom."
